Become a Host Family

(1)Have you ever thought about hosting an exchange student? What is more, your student will introduce his or her customs and culture to you. It will be like encountering a whole new culture without having to leave your home. As you can see, the mutual rewards gained when you

host an exchange student are extensive.

(3)When your student attends your local school, the classmates, teachers, and advisors who interact with him or her will be enriched. Fellow students and the entire school will learn from your student, while your student gains the valuable experience of education in a new culture. With each month of the school year, you will develop a stronger bond with this new family member, and in many cases this bond lasts for many years to come. A tearful farewell will come all too quickly, but nowadays with the convenience of communications and social media, there is little doubt that you and your exchange student will stay in contact.

(4)The initial meeting with your student will be full of anticipation, and you and the student may be a little nervous. We will help. Host families and students get information about one another ahead of time. You'll know about where your student comes from, what kind of family they have, and what they are interested in. And you don't have to wait until the day of the student's arrival. We recommend that host families write a letter to the student in order to break the ice. This way, you're no longer a mystery to them. They'll feel closer to you immediately.

(5)How do we select students for our program? Rest assured that there is a careful and thorough screening process. Connections International's offices in each region will evaluate prospective students. A teenager must demonstrate good grades in their studies, proper manners, and curiosity about the outside world to be selected for the program.
