Did you know that more than 80% of clothing eventually ends up in landfills or waste incinerators? And did you know that the average lifespan of a clothing item is about two years? People spend an average of \$1500 per year on clothes. They should last longer. And the (A) is to take better care of your clothes.

Here are some top tips to extend the life of your clothes:

1. **Wash Less Frequently:** Over-washing can damage fibers and fade colors. If an item isn't dirty, try hanging it outside to freshen up. Jeans and sweaters, for instance, don't need to be washed after every wear, unlike workout clothes which should be washed after each use.
2. **Lower Temperatures & Like Colors:** Washing at lower temperatures with gentle detergents helps prevent color fading and reduces emissions by 80% during the garment's lifecycle. Exceptions include underwear, bedding, and towels, which may need higher temperatures. Always wash like colors together to maintain vibrancy.
3. **Read Care Instructions:** To ensure proper care, (B) attention to the instructions on clothing labels. For example, wool should be washed only when necessary, using specific wool detergents on a gentle cycle or by hand.
4. **Eco-Friendly Detergents:** Choose sustainable powders and detergents to protect the environment. There are many eco-friendly options available today.
5. **Wash Inside Out:** This reduces friction and fading. Place delicate items in a mesh laundry bag for extra protection.
6. **Air Dry:** Tumble dryers use a lot of energy and can damage fibers. Hang clothes to dry, (C) inside or outside. Shake them out after washing to minimize wrinkles.

7. **Proper Storage:** Store sweaters and other knits with lavender or mothballs to protect against moths. Use wooden or padded hangers and ensure the hanger width matches the shirt shoulders. Fold along seams to maintain shape.
8. **Quality Over Quantity:** High-quality, properly-made clothing is an investment. Look for sturdy stitching and natural fabrics like organic cotton and linen, which last longer.
